Private School

in-person virtual tuition costs

dual enrollment:

- college/university (advanced opportunities funding IF the private school is accredited)
 - a charter school
 - local district school

official high school diploma
IF the private school is accredited

Public Charter School

in-person virtual free

dual enrollment:

- college/university (advanced opportunities funding)
- another charter school
- local district school

official high school diploma

Homeschool

in-person virtual resource costs

dual enrollment:

- college/university (advanced opportunities funding IF the student is dually enrolled in a public school or accredited private school)
 - a charter school
 - local district school

NO official high school diploma is issued

Dual Enrollment

Dual enrollment into a local district school or charter is an option only IF the student meets all requirements set by district or charter policy and if there is room in the programs in which the student wishes to dually enroll. Students must reside within the boundaries of the district or charter in which they wish to dually enroll.
